Creating a storyline for your film

All stories have a beginning, middle and an end. You need to decide the beginning, middle and end for your film!

You will need:

- To have decided which film and scene/s you are going to re-make
- Pens and paper

Activity:

1. Re-watch the original version of the film you want to re-make to remind yourself what happens.
2. Decide if your version will differ from the original, and if so, how
3. Now try to write the beginning, middle and end of the story using only one sentence for each. You will have to miss lots of things out! e.g:

Beginning: There were three bears that went for a walk to let their porridge cool down.

Middle: A little girl called Goldilocks went into their house, ate their porridge and fell asleep.

End: The bears came back and scared Goldilocks away

4. Use this as a basis for your script and storyboard – once you have made the storyline as simple as possible, you can decide what extras you want to add in!
